UPDATE ON LOCAL 1181 BARGAINING

International President Costa informed the General Executive Board that Local 1181 (New York, NY) has been in challenging bargaining with employers providing student transportation services for the New York City Department of Education. The employers have been intransigent regarding important issues such as addressing the second tiers in the current collective bargaining agreements.

MOTION APPROVED TO GRANT STRIKE SANCTION TO LOCAL 1181

Acting pursuant to its authority under Constitution and General Laws (CGL) Section 20.2, Strike Sanction, and upon a motion duly made and seconded, the members of the General Executive Board granted strike sanction to Local 1181 in connection with the ongoing dispute with student transportation providers for the NYC DOE, and to set the strike benefit rate at a rate of \$400 per week, subject to proration as per CGL Section 19.3, Strike Benefits.
